Dated, Chandigarh:

The Governor of Punjab is pleased to make the following amendments in the Punjab Epidemic Diseases, COVID-19 Regulation, 2020 issued vide vide Notification No.14/7/2020-4Health4/677 dated 5th March, 2020

Regulation-5 is replaced as follows:

"5. All Hospitals(Government and Private) during screening of suspected cases shall record the travel history of the person. In addition, the history of coming in contact with a suspected or confirmed case of COVID-19, all private hospitals must immediately inform the concerned Civil Surgeon. Government guidelines and health protocols must be followed by all suspected and confirmed cases of COVID-19."

2. Regulation-7 is replaced with the following:

"7.All Government and private Labs so authorized by the ICMR can take and/or test samples for COVID-19 in the state of Punjab. ICMR and Government of Punjab guidelines regarding taking & testing of samples must be followed. All private Labs in case they test samples must immediately share the results with the Civil Surgeons of the district."

3. Regulation-8 is replaced with the following:

"8. Any person who has travelled to a location outside, his usual residence should meticulously follow Government instructions including that of precautions and health protocols."

4. Regulation 9 is replaced as follows:

"9. Any person who may have travelled to any location, district, state or country as may be specified, may be required to quarantine at home or at any designated place for a period as may be prescribed. During such quarantine such persons shall take all required COVID precautions, hygiene measures, sanitization precautions and isolation measures as required and shall also utilize such digital equipment, mobile phone, mobile app, software system, tele-communication system etc. as may be prescribed, for the purpose of better management of COVID cases.
