Subject: Regarding Recruitment of Six Midwifery Educators for National Midwifery Training Institute (NMTI) at Patiala, Punjab

Govt. of India, Ministry of Health & Family Welfare has taken historic and landmark policy decision to roll out Midwifery Services in the Country to improve the quality of care and ensure respectful care to pregnant women and new borns. Under this initiative, one National Midwifery Training Institutes will be established at Government School of Nursing, Patiala in Punjab.

As per the Guidelines on Midwifery Services, pool of six State Level Midwifery Educators is required for State Midwifery Training Institute. The selection of six Midwifery Educators is to be made from candidates who are already in service.

You are therefore requested to send the nomination of the eligible candidates already in service under your kind control and are willing to apply for the post of Midwifery Educator and who fulfil the academic and experiential qualification as per details given below:

In-Service Candidates

Academic and Experiential Qualifications

- Essential Qualifications:
 - MSc/BSc Nursing candidate with a minimum of 5 years of clinical experience in Maternal care.
- Desirable Qualifications:
 - M.Sc. Nursing with speciality in obstetrics and gynaecology, paediatrics or community health with minimum 5 years of recent clinical maternity working experience.

Additional General Requirements- All candidates

- Age: upto 45 years
- Registration: Must be a registered R.N.R.M. with Indian Nursing Council
- Proficiency in basic computer usage

Entrance Process:

- Part-1 -Written test and OSCE
 - Written Test (40%): Multiple Choice Questions and two short essay (2 hours duration) covering the area of antenatal, intrapartum, postnatal, complication management and neonatal care. Short essays will be screened for technical proficiency as well as fluency in written English. Some weightage should be given for proficiency in written English.

 OSCE Objectively Structured Clinical Examination (20%): An OSCE bank based on current protocols under LaQshya

• Part-2-Interview (40%)

- Motivational Screening (20%): It involves screening for passion for woman's health, willingness to live in a different state for 6 months, willingness to serve after the training in a binding contract of 5 years, commitment to program goals and GoI's vision of providing quality of care around the time of birth.
- Aptitude assessment (20%): will be a part of interview process to ascertain spoken English language proficiency and communication, technical knowledge leadership and advocacy for client's rights, and team spirit.

The selected Midwifery Educators have to sign an undertaking stating that they will be committed to provide 5 years to training of Midwives at State Midwifery Institute at Patiala. It is mandatory for them to continue clinical practice in Labour room during the above duration and will be paid Rs. 15,000/- per month for 12 months as allowance on completion of training.

Kindly send the nominations by end of this month so that the recruitment process can be initiated at State Head Quarter at the earliest.
